Rukhsana Khan is an award-winning author and storyteller. She was born in Lahore, Pakistan and immigrated to Canada at the age of three. She grew up in a small town in Ontario and was bullied - she turned to books and became hopelessly addicted to the written word! When a teacher told her she was a writer, she thought that was impossible - writers were white people from England and America. She graduated from college as a biological-chemical technician instead. When she couldn't get a job in the field she decided to be 'unsensible' and become a writer. Now she has thirteen books published (one of which was chosen by the New York Public Library as one of the 100 greatest children's books in the last 100 years).
